

INTRODUCTION TO THE LITURGY OF THE DAY ~ As we approach the day when our elect will be baptized, confirmed, and receive the Eucharist for the first time, we celebrate three Scrutiny Sundays. The scrutiny rites are centered on the elect, but they need to involve the wider community. Together we pray that God may help the elect discover their spiritual weaknesses and strengths, may heal their tendencies toward sin, may protect them from temptation, and may guide them toward all that is good. We pray that God may continue to do so for the rest of us as well as we all journey together on the mission Jesus left us

We all need a savior to stick up for us, to come and quietly prune the unsightly growths that have taken root in our souls and turn the soil that has sat undisturbed for too long.


