





4th Sunday of Easter

The Gospel this Sunday speaks of Jesus as the good shepherd who will lead us out, watch over us, and safely gather us back into the fold. Even if we should stray from him, he will leave the others to seek us out and bring us back.



The safety of coming and going, in the diligent care of a shepherd was a very familiar expression of peace and safety for the people of Jesus' time.

The same sense of security that is expressed in this Gospel is no less assured to us today when we listen to the voice of Jesus, and we follow Him. He is the shepherd who watches over His flock and leads us safely to eternal life.

Jesus' sheep know his voice and that is how we continue to follow Him. So, let us take a moment today to reflect on the ways that we hear His voice.

His voice can take many forms in our lives. Often the voice of Jesus comes to us through the people around us, through family and friends, co-workers, teachers and classmates.

Among all these people in our lives, the ordained clergy, the religious and ...especially our pastor... are special ways that we hear Jesus' voice. So, Good Shepherd Sunday is also called Vocation Sunday, and it is kept as a World Day of Prayer for vocations, especially for those to the priesthood.

So, praying for vocations is the first thing we are encouraged to do today. Yet Vocations Sunday doesn't stop there; we all have a vocation and we all can be the voice of Jesus to others. Every one of us has a call from God to serve each other and to share in the task of reaching out to those who are lost.

So today we also consider the ways we exercise our own vocation.

No matter what our work or profession is, we are first followers of Jesus who share our gifts in ways which contribute to the wellbeing of our communities and witness our faith in Christ to others.

It is a tremendous grace, for me, and I think for all of us, to be part of this community, which responds so generously to this call.

So, we pray also for ourselves this Sunday, for the continued Grace to hear his voice and respond with generous hearts, as we have so faithfully done in the past.
