

Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

A little boy was kneeling by his bed praying one evening with his mother and grandmother nearby. "Dear God," he said, "please bless mommy and daddy and the whole family and give us a good night's sleep." When he seemed to be finished, he suddenly he looked up and shouted, "Oh, and please don't forget to send me a new bicycle for my birthday." At that his mother got a bit upset and said, "There is no reason to shout like that, God isn't deaf." But he replied, "No, but Grandma is." Now, that little boy in this story knew something about God that might help us to understand the story of Jesus and the Canaanite woman in the Gospel today. He knew that God might work through his Grandmother to get him that bicycle. After all, it is true that God often uses other people to get things done. Today's Gospel is difficult for us to understand because it portrays Jesus being uncharacteristically harsh to push the woman away who is asking for mercy. He even goes so far as to belittle the woman and pronounce her unworthiness by calling her a dog. Now, that is not the same Jesus that we know and love. The Jesus I know is merciful and welcoming to everyone who truly places their hope in him. If we think about it, there is something more here. With these the harsh responses, Jesus is using this woman and her situation to teach us about his mercy. He is using the woman as an example that he came bring mercy for all people and all nations. The first reading today made clear how God's intends his house to be a place of prayer for all people; that all who love him and do right and keep his covenant will be acceptable to Him. So, this helps us better understand the Gospel because Jesus could not possibly have meant that only the Jews would receive his mercy. In the course of his exchange with the Canaanite woman, Jesus proved that even though he was sent first to the Jews as their Messiah, his mercy is for all God's people. God's people are those who are steadfast in placing their hope in Him. The Canaanite woman was a person despised of by the Jews. She worshiped other Gods, she engaged in unholy and unclean practices and she was the perfect example of one who could not be any less worthy of receiving God's mercy according to the law. In the Gospel, Jesus went to great length to point out that fact. Yet, Jesus showed mercy over and over in the Gospels to anyone who asked no matter how sinful. So, he would not have been turning this woman away because of her sinfulness. Even, the second reading from Paul today teaches us that God has delivered all of us to disobedience so that he might have mercy upon all people.

In the end, this woman showed Him that she truly believed that He was the Messiah. She called him by the messianic titles, Son of David and Lord. In her persistence, she showed a steadfast faith in Him as the one who could heal her daughter and as the one in whom she should place her hopes. It was because of her great faith and hope in Him that her daughter was healed.

So the lesson here today is that trust in Jesus and persistence in our faith, no matter how unworthy we are or how far we have wandered from God is the only true requirement to receive his mercy. May God's peace be with you all!
