



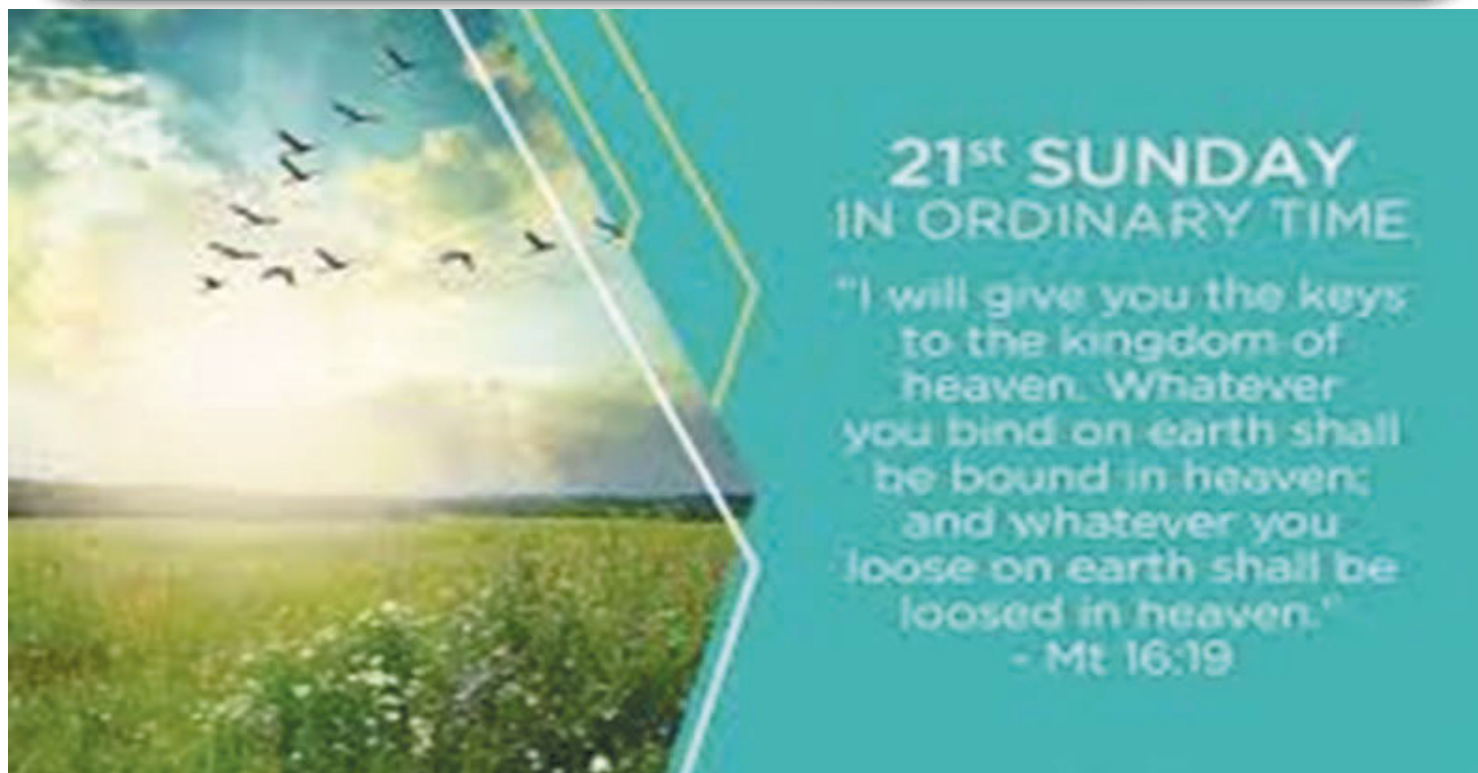

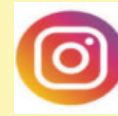

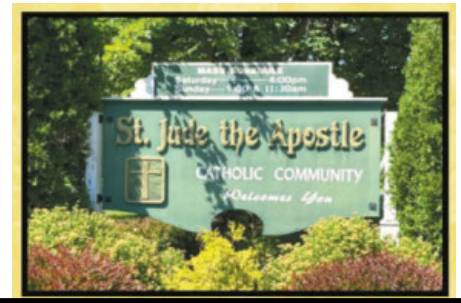

Twenty First Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

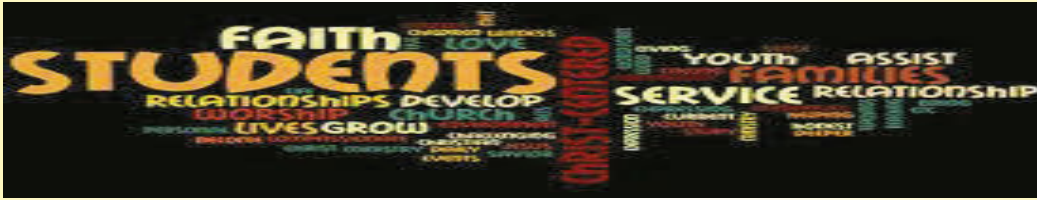
Today the readings call us to reflect on the mystery of God. The second reading from Paul's letter to the Romans gives us an insight to Paul's reflection on the mystery of God. "Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How inscrutable are his judgments and how unsearchable are his ways!" Paul states that God's judgments and ways are vastly beyond our understanding. Does this mean that we just throw up our hands and say, "what's the point?"

No. What does Jesus ask the disciples in the gospel passage? "...who do you say that I am?" Peter replies, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." How does Peter come to know this? Does Peter have a special insight or the wisdom or knowledge of God? No, but Peter does have a desire to know and love Jesus. He desires not to shy away from the mystery, but to embrace it and surrender to it. Surrendering means to desire to know and love God as God wills. This is why Peter can say Jesus is the Son of the living God.

God is a mystery, not to be solved or figured out. Rather God is a mystery that we desire to know and love more deeply. God's grants us graces to glimpse and taste God's riches, wisdom, and knowledge. Three weeks ago, the Church celebrated the Transfiguration of Jesus. Peter, James, and John were granted the grace to glimpse and taste the glory of God by seeing Jesus transfigured. Another way to consider this, is that Peter, James, and John so deeply desired to know and love Jesus that their blindness to God's glory was lifted by grace and they experienced Jesus as we really was.

The glorious mysteries of God lie before us, and we are invited to glimpse and experience them. God who knew and loved us first, invites us to know and love God's self. Yes, God is inscrutable and unsearchable, but that should draw us to God even more. I pray brothers and sisters that you desire to know and love God so that you might grow in awareness of God's presence in your life.

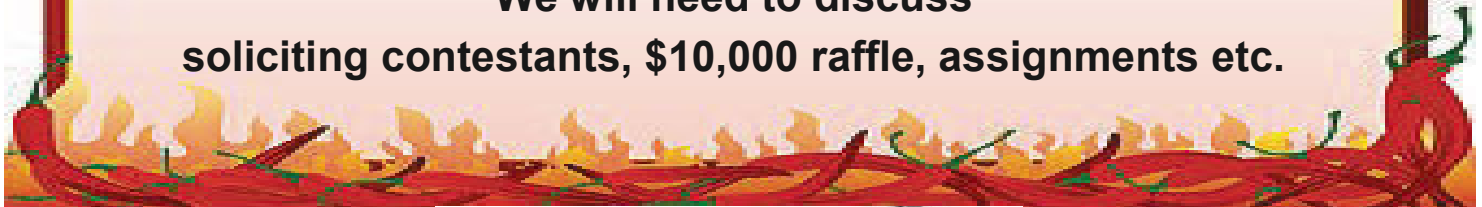




Living with Loss
