

Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Middle School/ High School Youth Ministry Program "Teen Pathways" Gr. 7-10

Teen Pathways is a Youth Ministry program grades 7-10th for St. Jude the Apostle Parish. Teens wishing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation must be involved in the program for a minimum of 2 years in Grades 9th & 10th. We meet in the St Jude School gymnasium starting in September. Our first meeting begins with an orientation. 9th and 10th grade students meet throughout the year at 9 am and 7th and 8th meet at 9:45 am. This allows us to meet before Mass and not hinder any afternoon functions for families. All classes are held on Sunday's.
