



## Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today's first reading and Gospel call us to reflect upon the things we seek in this lifetime. King Solomon, son of King David, prayed to God asking for an understanding heart, distinguishing right from wrong. To put it in contemporary terms, Solomon was praying for the grace of discernment, to seek the will of God for him in his life. God granted this grace to Solomon, saying, "Because you have asked for this—not for a long life for yourself, nor for riches, nor for the life of your enemies, but for understanding so that you may know what is right—I do as you requested." Solomon does not seek power, wealth, honor, or pleasure for himself. These are the earthly desires that detract our focus from God. In and of themselves these desires are not wrong or evil, however when we no longer seek to discern the will of God for our lives then these desires become disordered.

Jesus provides us with three parables that speak about seeking and discerning the good things in this life. The treasure in the field, the pearl, and the fishermen's net, they all represent the graces given to us by God. When we recognize these graces and embrace them, we realize that there are things we must sacrifice for them. What we are required to sacrifice are our disordered desires for power, wealth, honor, and pleasure. When we place our focus and hearts upon the graces God provides, we come to realize that God indeed provides us with all we need in this life.

Brothers and sisters let our prayer be that of Solomon, let us pray for an understanding heart of discernment. Not discerning disorder desires but seeking how our desires can co-operate with the desires God has for us. May the peace of Christ be with you all, Deacon Nick



## Middle School/ High School Youth Ministry Program "Teen Pathways" Gr. 7-10

Teen Pathways is a Youth Ministry program grades 7-10th for St. Jude the Apostle Parish. Teens wishing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation must be involved in the program for a minimum of 2 years in Grades 9th & 10th. We meet in the St Jude School gymnasium starting in September. Our first meeting begins with an orientation. 9th and 10th grade students meet throughout the year at 9 am and 7th and 8th meet at 9:45 am. This allows us to meet before Mass and not hinder any afternoon functions for families. All classes are held on Sunday's.

Faith formation activities throughout the year include: retreats,- service opportunities - family liturgies, - 1st Friday of month gatherings (voluntary & grade specific)
