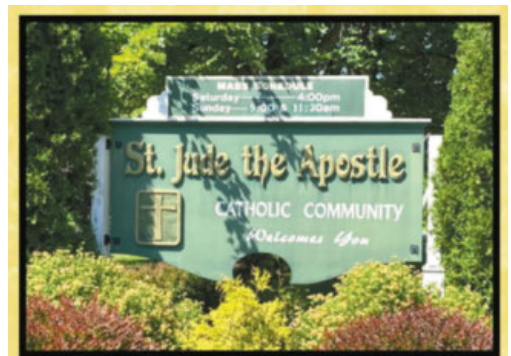

# Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time



It seems like our faith today is under attack in our society. Our ability to remain true to our discipleship is becoming more and more difficult. Right now, standing up for the lives of the unborn and praying or even witnessing to Christ in schools or workplaces can cause you to be treated like you are some kind of domestic terrorist.

In the face of this opposition, the Gospels of the last two weeks challenge us to be bold in our witnessing. We should "fear no one" because we are more valuable to him than many sparrows and He watches over even the hairs of our heads. "Everyone who acknowledges me before others I will acknowledge before my Heavenly Father." So let us not cower in the face of today's opposition to our beliefs, rather stand up even more steadfastly for our belief in Christ. "If God is for us, who can be against us?"

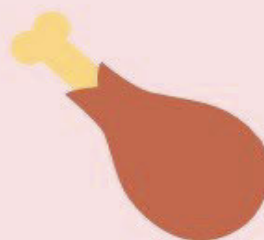
