5th Sunday of Easter

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today's readings call us to reflect on the work or mission that God calls us to in this life. Each of us by virtue of our baptism is call to co-operate with God for the purpose of the mission of the Church. No matter our careers, age, language, background, or limitations, God works through us for the betterment of God's kingdom and the betterment of those we encounter. God recognizes our human dignity and graces us with gifts to complement our human dignity to help others. It is our responsibility to co-operate with God through prayer and use the graces God bestows on us.

In the first reading we hear of the apostles actively discerning and praying about what will become the mission of the diaconate. Stephen is called by the Holy Spirit, working through the community of faith, to fulfil the mission of ministering to the widows and orphans, that is, ministering to the greater community beyond the church community. That is a large part of the mission of the diaconate to minister to the greater community, bringing the prayers and concerns of the community into the walls of the church. This is why the deacon is tasked with praying the intercessions at Mass. Listen to the intercessions during Mass, we pray for concerns of the greater community. For church leaders, local and global leaders, the sick and poor of the community, and for those members of the community who have died.

In the gospel Jesus tells us, "Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever believes in me will do the works that I do..." How do you participate in God's mission for the church? What is your role in helping bring about the Kingdom of God, here and now? These are the questions we called to reflect on today. These questions are not only reserved for those who are ordained or live in consecrated life. If you are baptized these questions are central to your relationship with God and those you encounter.

Brothers and sisters, please take time to reflect on the graces God has bestowed on you and how you co-operate with God to fully participate in the mission of the Church. May the peace of Christ be with you. Deacon Nick
