GOSPEL REFLECTION, ADORATION and MINISTRIES

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We should always be ready to reflect and think when we hear the words, "Jesus told his disciples this *parable*..." Jesus told parables to cause us to think, reflect, and pray on his words. Parables do not reveal the message of the story on a silver platter.

The parable we hear today is no different. If we were to look at the parable of the talents superficially, we might think, "Well, Jesus is rewarding those who invest their money wisely and punish those who don't." This interpretation, of course, does not fit all with the other teachings of Jesus.

Today's parable requires us to hear this passage as the Jewish community would have heard it, easier said than done. A *talent* in Jesus' times does not mean what it means in 2023. A *talent* in ancient times was a measure of something particularly heavy, usually silver or gold. From a faith perspective, for the Jewish people, what carried the heaviest weight of all was the *mercy* of God. It is the mercy of God that is at the heart of this parable.

The *talents* given by the master in this parable are a share in God's mercy. Therefore, two of the servants accepted a share of God's mercy and shared with others. We find that the third servant accepted a share in God's mercy but did not share it with others, this was the mistake he made. It is related to the parable of the person who hid his lamp so no one else could see the light.

This parable is a wonderful reminder of God's invitation for us to be in relationship with God. When we receive God's graces we are not to keep them for ourselves, rather we are to share these graces unconditionally with others, that is how we return love to God.

Today, brothers and sisters, we give gratitude for God's grace in our life. We ask God for eyes of faith to see and acknowledge God's grace and pray for the strength and courage to share God's grace with others. Without counting the costs and without being judgmental, as it is not up to us to judge who is deserving of God's grace. When we encounter God's mercy, forgiveness, and love, may we not keep it for ourselves but extend and share those graces with others.


