




Grades 5<sup>th</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> will be decorating pumpkins with the residents of St. Jude Apartments

Grades 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> have been learning and practicing Acts of Kindness and making the world a better place!





## GOSPEL REFLECTION, ADORATION and MINISTRIES

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today we hear an account from the Gospel of Matthew chapter 22. This chapter offers four encounters Jesus has with the Jewish authority, who are hoping to trap him in a lie or contradiction. The pharisees were questioning Jesus about secular authority and how Christians are called to respond. The passage ends with Jesus saying, "Then repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God."

We can reflect upon the challenges we face as we navigate this life as Christians. We live in this world and follow the laws that govern us, however the world does not offer us insight as to how we live. Sure, we have laws that protect property and some aspects of life, but we also find those same ideas in the Ten-Commandments.

Jesus gives us the Beatitudes, blessed are the poor in spirit, those who mourn, etc. Those are teachings that guide us in our interactions with one another. In addition to the Beatitudes is the greatest command: "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the greatest and the first commandment. The second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself." Jesus recites this to the pharisees in Matthew 22.

We live in this world in light of our relationship with Jesus Christ.

Consider the relationships we have with friends and family, they sometimes have influence over what we say, how we behave, and decisions that we make. Society sometimes has the same influence over us, usually ruled by the questions "what will people think?" As Christians, we strive to break free from the slavery of such influences and embrace the freedom found in a life lived in and through Jesus. That is the challenge. We can give to "Caesar" the material things of this world, but have we given to God what belongs to God? Another way is to ask, do we give ourselves to God? Do we strive to love those we encounter, for the betterment of others and the glory of God? These are challenging questions to reflect upon, however they help us strengthen our relationship with Jesus and with others.

Brothers and sisters, let us pray for the desire, strength, and courage to reflect on these questions, to answer them honestly. When our reflection reveals that we have fallen short, let us seek forgiveness and reconciliation with others and with God. When our reflection awakens us to the graces God gives let us offer gratitude to God.
