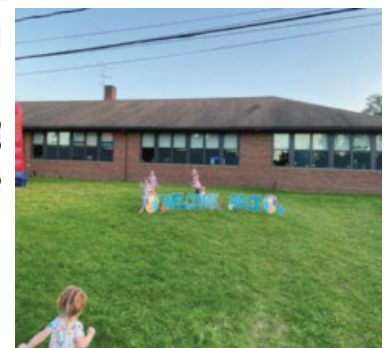

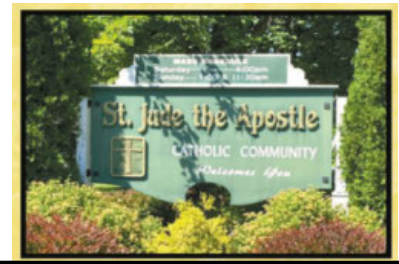
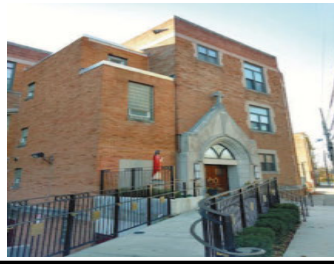

**Twenty Third Sunday in Ordinary Time**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Jesus calls us to nurture those relationships, willing the good for the other and not put obstacles in their way.

Brothers and sisters, let us pray that God will offer us the grace to be patient with one another, to will the good for one another, and in co-operation with God, take responsibility for getting each other to eternal life in the loving presence of God.

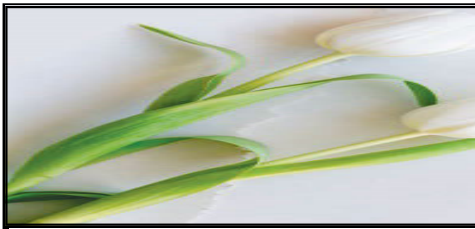

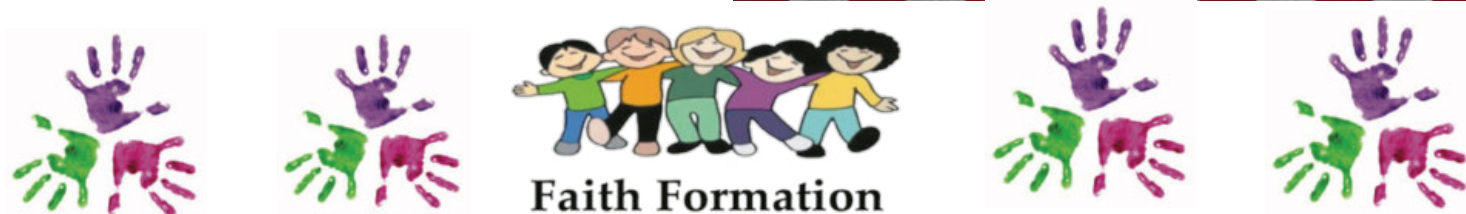
## RESPECT LIFE
