

Twenty Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today's readings call us to reflect on our spiritual well-being. Certainly, there is a concern for fairness in the gospel passage from Matthew, however we can also consider this passage in a spiritual light.

Workers in the vineyard come to work at different times during the day and the owner of the vineyard graciously chooses to compensate all who work equally, with the same wage, regardless of the number of hours they worked. That is the gist of the passage. However, let us consider this passage in an analogous way.


The vineyard is a relationship with the Trinity to which we are invited. God is the owner of the vineyard and no matter when we accept the invitation to this relationship, God welcomes us. Whether baptized as an infant or a "deathbed" baptism, all are welcomed by God.

We are all at different points in our spiritual/faith journey in this life and those differences ought to be honored and supported. We all play a role in journeying with one another in this life, as we pray in the Baptismal Rite: "...we [the Church] offer you our support in raising your child in the practice of the faith." There is no expiration date on this promise. This is why we should seek to grow in our faith, no matter what our age. Faith formation is not only for children, all ages need to be engaged in faith formation. "Seek the Lord while he may be found..." is an invitation and encouragement for us to continue to deepen our relationship with the Trinity. As individuals we seek the will of God, so that we may confidently proclaim, as St. Paul did, "Christ will be magnified in my body, whether by life or by death. For to me life is Christ, and death is gain. If I go on living in the flesh, that means fruitful labor for me." Brothers and Sisters in Christ let us reflect on where we are in our journey of faith. Let us seek to grow in a deeper relationship with God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit through prayer, community, and faith formation. Lastly, may we recognize where others are in their journey of faith, encourage and support them in growing in love and faith.

May the peace of Christ be with all of you.
