

GOSPEL REFLECTION

This week's readings are all about the existence of evil in our world. In the first reading we find the story of what happened when Adam and Eve had engaged in evil for the first time.

The immediate consequence of this sin was the naked shame of having lost their innocence. They hid from God because they knew they had acted contrary to His will. When confronted by God, they also failed to take responsibility for their own actions and shifted blame for the incident.

The serpent which represented the source of evil was banned to lead the most lowly of existences in all creation and was set in conflict with the woman and all here progeny. The last line introduces the ongoing strike and counter strike between the offspring of both the serpent and the woman. This not only represents mankind's ongoing struggle with evil, but also foreshadows the final victory of the Christ, Son of the new Eve, Mary.

The Gospel this week continues the discussion of evil in the world. It begins with the incident of Jesus own relatives saying that he must be out of his mind. In those day's that would be equivalent to saying he is possessed with an evil spirit which is exactly how the scribes responded to the incident. They accused him of driving out demons with demonic power over them.

Jesus responded to them by pointing out that Satan can't drive out Satan, a divided house cannot stand nor can a divided kingdom stand. He warns them of the unforgiven sin of blasphemy against the spirit; in this context calling Jesus, the Lord, a Satanic Spirit.

The final part of this Gospel returns to the incident of Jesus own relatives calling him 'out of his mind'. When Jesus referred to His mother and brothers, he is referring to his relatives in the broader sense. This is especially true of the term brothers when in the Catholic tradition of the perpetual virginity of Mary, he would have had no brothers. So, here, he flatly rejects a familiar association with those relatives who do evil or act contrary to God's will.

So, our takeaway from the readings this week is to take seriously the existence of evil in our world and to keep ourselves on the right side of this ongoing battle. We are all adopted into the family of God and brotherhood of Jesus at our baptism, therefore let us do our best to keep all forms of evil from creeping into our lives.
