



EWTN will offer special programming to celebrate the Jubilee year including the Canonization of Blessed Carlo Acutis on April 27th. CHECK EWTEEN LISTING FOR THE TIME

Carlo Acutis will be canonized on April 27, 2025. Carlos, known for his deep devotion to the Catholic faith and his adept use of technology to share religious content, is set to become the first millennial saint. Pope Francis has officially recognized a second miracle attributed to Acutis and approved his canonization. He passed away in 2006 at the age of 15 due to leukemia. He has been admired for his work in creating a website documenting Eucharistic miracles worldwide. His beatification took place in October 2020, and the recent recognition of a second miracle—an essential step in the process—marks the final phase towards sainthood.
