

Have you ever been dehydrated? If so, you know how awful it makes you feel. Lethargy, weakness, dizziness- the list goes on. Stay out of the hot sun as much as possible. Wear a hat and light colored, loose-fitting clothing. If your urine remains dark in color, see your health care provider. There may be a more serious problem occurring.
