

It was a very welcoming turn out and all who attended were touched by John's presentation.



Now that summer is here, it is time to remind folks about food safety in the summer. When barbecuing meat, cook it thoroughly-only minimal red, better yet, NO red, should be showing with beef to make sure the meat is safe with no bacteria. Keep salads out of refrigeration for no more than 2 hours. Provide lots of water, especially if you are serving alcohol or caffeine products. Alcohol and caffeine can cause dehydration, so a glass of water after every one of these beverages is a good habit to avoid becoming dehydrated in the hot sun.
