Colon Cancer is recognized in the month of March every year. Colorectal Cancer often goes unnoticed at the onset as often there are no symptoms. The following should <u>not</u> be ignored-change in bowel habits, i.e., more frequent diarrhea or constipation, rectal bleeding or blood in the stool, ongoing discomfort in the abdomen-cramps, gas, or pain, or weight loss without trying. A colonoscopy is the usual test done after the age of 50 but perhaps at an earlier age if there is a history of polyps, inflammatory bowel disease or a family history of colorectal cancer. Any of these concerns should be brought to the attention of your primary care provider, sooner rather than later. Early detection allows for a better chance for a healthier outcome.


