

Alzheimer's disease, the most common form of dementia, is a brain condition that gets worse over time and has no cure. Alzheimer's disease can occur when a protein called amyloid continuously builds up in the brain, forming harmful amyloid brain plaque. Though there are different types of amyloid proteins, all of them can damage brain cells. Early signs and symptoms can include the inability to complete simple tasks, misplacing important items, like keys or wallet, or difficulty managing finances to mention a few. Early diagnosis by a physician is key to begin treatment after diagnosis. Much research is being done, including new medications. This disease affects a whole family. Don't hesitate to see a physician if there are concerns.
