**Roman Catholic Diocese of Albany
 Victims/Survivors Compensation Plan**

In early July, Bishop Scharfenberger released the draft of a Victims/Survivors Compensation Plan, hoping to get the word out to Victims/Survivors as they consider their options regarding the New York State Child Victims Act (CVA) lawsuits. A draft of this plan is available on the table in the back of the church.

Also available is a letter from the Bishop briefly explaining the courses of action that may be taken by the diocese of Albany to address the claims. One is the path of litigation; another is to file for bankruptcy (Chapter 11); and a third is to secure the greatest portion of finite funds for all, not just a few, survivors who have filed claims under the CVA.

You are welcome to take a copy of one or both documents.



FEAST OF ST. JOACHIM AND ST. ANNE

On **July 26th**, the Church remembers St. Joachim and St. Anne, the parents of the Virgin Mary. Despite the importance of their role as the maternal grandparents of Jesus, we do not know too much about them; they are not mentioned in the Scriptures.

It is thought that Joachim was a shepherd from Jerusalem. They did not have any children, and they were a rather elderly couple when, one day, while Joachim was at work in the fields as usual, an angel appeared to announce the birth of a child, and Anne also had the same vision. So they called their little girl Mary, which means “loved by God,” and then they moved to Nazareth, where they educated her, teaching her the law of the Lord. We do not know when Joachim and Anne died, and for many centuries their memory remained in the shadows.

Even though we do not know a lot about them, we honor Mary’s parents as saints. We celebrate with joy their joint feast today. Their love for one another and for Mary is an example to us of how God calls us to live. They also remind us to honor our own grandparents and to thank them for the blessings they have passed down to us in love.

Let us pray.

“God of our fathers and mothers in the faith, you gave Saints Anne and Joachim the privilege of being the parents of Mary, the mother of your incarnate Son. May their prayers help us to attain the salvation you have promised to your people. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.”

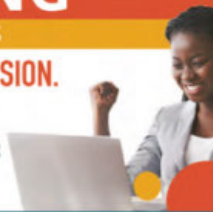
