During the months of January and February, we will only accept masses requested by parishioners or for parishioners.

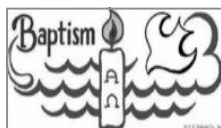


**CEMETERY CLEAN-UP**

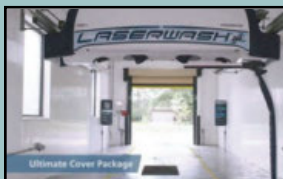
