**SAINT JOHN PAUL II  
October 22**

On May 2, 2014, Pope Francis ordered the inscription of St. John Paul II into the General Roman Calendar. St. John Paul is celebrated each year on October 22.

On October 16, 1978, he was elected Supreme Pontiff and took the name John Paul II. Among the many fruits which he has left as a heritage to the Church are above all his rich body of teachings, the promulgation of the Catechism of the Catholic Church, and of the Codes of Canon Law for the Latin Church and for the Eastern Churches. In Rome on April 2, 2005, the eve of the Second Sunday of Easter (or Divine Mercy), he died peacefully in the Lord.
