DAILY MASS ON MONDAYs and TUESDAYs

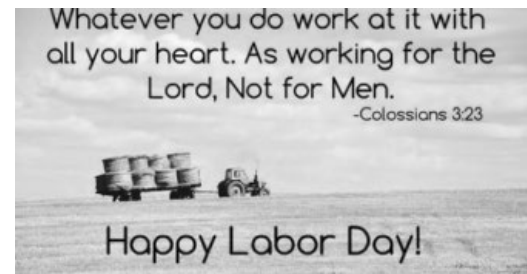

NATIVITY OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY Thursday, September 8

This feast day commemorates the birth day of Mary. There are only three birthdays on the liturgical calendar: Mary, Jesus, and John the Baptist. Usually, it is the custom to celebrate the feast day of a saint on the date of their death as that marks their "birth" into everlasting life. Mary, however, entered the world sinless (known as the "Immaculate Conception"). She was born to be the mother of the Savior of the world, the spiritual mother of all men, and the holiest of God's creatures. Mary is called the firstborn of the redeemed and her nativity is "the hope of the entire world and the dawn of salvation"
