**The Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows  
Thursday, September 15.**

This feast commemorates the sorrowful Mother and the sufferings she experienced in union with her Son and dates back to the 12th century. The feast was extended to the universal Church in 1817 by Pope Pius VII and fixed officially in the calendar for September 15 in 1913 by Pope Pius X. This feast reminds us of the spiritual martyrdom of Our Blessed Mother and her compassion with the sufferings of her divine Son. Through her great sufferings as co-redeemer, she also helps to show us the true evil of sin and thereby leads us to repentance and salvation.

*(From the Roman Missal)*

The seven sorrows of Mary are:

1. The Prophecy of Simeon at the Presentation in the Temple (Lk 2:22-35)  
“... (and a sword will pierce through your own soul also), that thoughts out of many hearts may be revealed.”
2. The Flight into Egypt (Mt 2:13-21)
3. The Loss of Jesus in the Temple (Lk 2:41-50)
4. Mary Encounters Jesus on the Way of the Cross (John 19:1; Luke 23:26-32)
5. Jesus Dies on the Cross (Mark 15:22; John 19:18, 25-27; Mark 15:34; Luke 23:46)
6. Jesus Is Taken Down From the Cross (John 19:31-34, 38; Lam 1:12)
7. Jesus is Laid in the Tomb (Matthew 27:59; John 19:38-42; Mark 15:46; Luke 27:55-56)

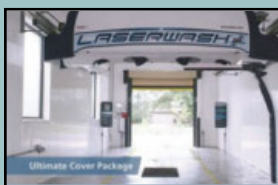
