SAINTS MICHAEL, GABRIEL & RAPHAEL, ARCHANGELS

We are familiar with **St. Michael the Archangel, the Protector and Defender**; and we know **St. Gabriel the Archangel as the Messenger of God**. But less is known of St. Raphael. **Archangel Raphael is known as the Angel of Healing**. He is full of compassion on people who are struggling physically, mentally, emotionally, or spiritually. Raphael works to bring people closer to God so they can experience the peace God wants to give them. He is often associated with joy and laughter. Raphael also works to heal animals and the Earth, so people connect him to animal care and environmental efforts.

People sometimes ask for Raphael's help to: heal them (of illnesses or injuries that are physical, mental, emotional, or spiritual in nature), help them overcome addictions, lead them to love, and keep them safe while traveling. Raphael means "God heals."

Christians from denominations such as the Catholic, Anglican, and Orthodox churches venerate Raphael as a saint. He serves as the patron saint of people in the medical profession (such as doctors and nurses), patients, counselors, pharmacists, love, young people, and travelers.
