Parish Sacristan

In general this role serves as a coordinator for worship services, ensuring that linens are pressed and clean, that altar vessels are kept safe, that consumables like altar wines and altar bread are in adequate supply, and that the church as a whole is kept secure.

Duties include opening and locking the church for liturgies and services including funerals and other church events, and preparing the Altar and sanctuary for all liturgies on weekends. The sacristan works with the pastor to attend to the environment of worship.

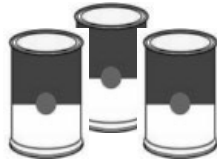
